AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. MURPHY

Viz:

1       At the end, add the following:

2   **SEC. 8. REPORTS ON FENTANYL FROM CANADA.**

3       (a) IN GENERAL.—The Attorney General, the Sec-  
 4   retary of Homeland Security, and the Secretary of State  
 5   shall jointly—

6           (1) not later than 30 days after the date of the  
 7   enactment of this Act, and every 30 days there-  
 8   after—

9           (A) report the total percentage of fentanyl  
 10   entering the United States from Canada; and

1 (B) make such report publicly available;

2 and

3 (2) immediately notify Congress if the total per-  
4 centage of fentanyl entering the United States from  
5 Canada ever exceeds 1 percent.

6 (b) ELEMENTS.—The information reported under  
7 subsection (a) shall specify—

8 (1) the percentage of fentanyl entering the  
9 United States from Canada—

10 (A) through international mail; and

11 (B) interdicted at sea;

12 (2) the citizenship of the person, or persons,  
13 bringing such fentanyl into the United States; and

14 (3) the manner in which such fentanyl entered,  
15 whether through or between the ports of entry.
