	OPENING STATEMENT OF HON. BOB CORKER, U.S. SENATOR FROM TENNESSEE
5	THE CHAIRMAN. This business meeting of the Senate Foreign Relations
б	Committee will come to order. Today we consider the nomination of John Sullivan to be
7	Deputy Secretary of State and two Foreign Service Officer Lists.
8	I thank my colleagues for allowing the committee to take these steps forward
9	today.
10	I know that there is concern over the reorganization that is taking place at the
11	State Department, and what that will ultimately look like. I think Mr. Sullivan will bring
12	a wealth of both management and government experience to help the transition go
13	smoothly.

2	SENATOR CARDIN. I agree with the Chairman.
3	THE CHAIRMAN. Do we have a quorum?
