- 1 (2) REPORT ON STATUS OF IMPLEMENTATION 2 OF RECOMMENDATIONS.—Not later than 90 days 3 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-4 retary of State and the Secretary of Defense shall 5 report to the appropriate congressional committees 6 on the status of implementation, within their respec-7 tive departments, of each recommendation included 8 in the report referenced in paragraph (1).
