## A BILL

To provide for the treatment of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) as an international organization for purposes of the International Organizations Immunities Act, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Providing Appropriate
- 5 Recognition and Treatment Needed to Enhance Relations
- 6 with ASEAN Act" or the "PARTNER with ASEAN Act".

1	SEC. 2. STATEMENT OF POLICY ON DEEPENING COOPERA-
2	TION WITH ASEAN.
3	It is the policy of the United States—
4	(1) to reaffirm the United States-ASEAN Com-
5	prehensive Strategic Partnership, established in
6	2022 following 45 years of Dialogue Partnership;
7	(2) to enhance United States-ASEAN coopera-
8	tion in support of an open, transparent, resilient, in-
9	clusive and rules-based regional architecture in the
10	Indo-Pacifie;
11	(3) to support regular, high-level United States
12	official engagement with ASEAN, including the par-
13	ticipation in the annual ASEAN Summit held each
14	year;
15	(4) to enhance cooperation with ASEAN mem-
16	ber states as well as with the institution of ASEAN
17	and the ASEAN Secretariat, including through the
18	United States Mission to ASEAN, led by the United
19	States Ambassador to ASEAN; and
20	(5) to welcome the decision in-principle by
21	ASEAN to admit Timor-Leste to be ASEAN's 11th
22	member state and to encourage United States sup-
23	port to Timor-Leste in its capacity as an official
24	ASEAN observer.
