AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. RUBIO

Viz:

1 On page 7, strike lines 3 through 8 and insert the 2 following: "and human rights abuses;

3 (6) United States citizens should not travel to
4 the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, and the
5 Department of State should launch a public aware6 ness campaign about the risks and dangers of such
7 travel;

8 (7) the United States should continue to seek 9 cooperation from all foreign governments to allow 10 the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees 11 access to process North Korean refugees overseas 12 for resettlement and to allow United States officials $\mathbf{2}$

1 access to process refugees for resettlement in the 2 United States (if that is the destination country of 3 the refugees' choosing); 4 (8) the Secretary of State, through persistent 5 diplomacy by senior officials, including United 6 States ambassadors to Asia-Pacific countries, and in 7 close cooperation with United States ally South 8 Korea, should make every effort to promote the pro-9 tection of North Korean refugees and defectors; and

10 (9) because North Koreans fleeing into China
11 face a well-founded fear of persecution upon their
12 forcible repatriation, the United States should urge
13 China to—

14 (A) immediately halt the forcible repatri-15 ation of North Koreans;

(B) allow the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees unimpeded access to
North Koreans inside China to determine
whether such North Koreans require protection
as refugees; and

(C) fulfill its obligations under the 1951
United Nations Convention Relating to the Status of Refugees, the 1967 Protocol Relating to
the Status of Refugees, and the Agreement on
the Upgrading of the UNHCR Mission in the
