6               the Office of Victim Advocacy and the avail-  
7               ability of the Office of Victim Advocacy as a re-  
8               source for volunteers; and

9               “(D) the contact information of the Office  
10              of Victim Advocacy.

1       Beginning on page 18, strike line 23 and all that fol-  
2 lows through page 19, line 2, and insert the following:

3           “(7) maintains a record documenting the res-  
4  ignation of any employee or volunteer of the Peace  
5  Corps who resigns before a determination has been  
6  made regarding an alleged violation of the sexual  
7  misconduct policy or other serious policy violations;

8       On page 19, strike lines 7 through 9 and insert the  
9 following:

10           “(9) provides orientation or information regard-  
11  ing the awareness and prevention of sexual assault  
12  to—

13           “(A) Peace Corps-selected host families;  
14           and

15           “(B) a designated person of authority at  
16           the volunteer’s initial workplace.”.

17       On page 19, strike lines 23 and 24 and insert the  
18 following:

19           (2) by striking subsection (e).
