A BILL

To permit visiting dignitaries and service members from
Taiwan to display the flag of the Republic of China.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. REQUIREMENT TO PERMIT DIGNITARIES AND**
2 **SERVICE MEMBERS FROM TAIWAN TO DIS-**
3 **PLAY THE FLAG OF THE REPUBLIC OF CHINA.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of State and the
5 Secretary of Defense shall permit members of the Armed
6 Forces and Government representatives from the Republic
7 of China (Taiwan) or the Taipei Economic and Cultural
8 Representative Office (TECRO) to display, for the official
9 purposes set forth in subsection (b), symbols of Republic
10 of China sovereignty, including—

11 (1) the flag of the Republic of China (Taiwan);

12 and

13 (2) the corresponding emblems or insignia of
14 military units.

15 (b) OFFICIAL PURPOSES.—The official purposes re-
16 ferred to in subsection (a) are—

17 (1) the wearing of official uniforms;

18 (2) conducting government hosted ceremonies
19 or functions; and

20 (3) appearances on Department of State and
21 Department of Defense social media accounts pro-
22 moting engagements with Taiwan.

1 **SECTION 1. REQUIREMENT TO PERMIT DIGNITARIES AND**

4 (a) *IN GENERAL.*—*The Secretary of State and the Sec-*
5 *retary of Defense shall permit members of the Armed Forces*
6 *and representatives from Taiwan or the Taipei Economic*
7 *and Cultural Representative Office (TECRO) to display,*
8 *for the purposes set forth in subsection (b), the following*
9 *symbols:*

10 (1) *the flag of Taiwan; and*

11 (2) *the corresponding emblems or insignia of*
12 *military units.*

13 (b) *PURPOSES.*—*The purposes referred to in subsection*
14 *(a) are—*

15 (1) *the wearing of official uniforms;*

16 (2) *conducting ceremonies or functions; and*

17 (3) *appearances on Department of State and De-*
18 *partment of Defense social media accounts promoting*
19 *engagements with Taiwan.*

20 **SEC. 2. RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.**

21 *Nothing in this Act shall be construed as a change to*
22 *the One China Policy of the United States, which is guided*
23 *by the Taiwan Relations Act (22 U.S.C. 3301 et seq.), the*
24 *three United States-People's Republic of China Joint Com-*
25 *muniques, and the Six Assurances.*
