Whereas Article II of the United States Constitution empowers the President, as Commander-in-Chief, to direct the use of military force to protect the Nation from an attack or threat of imminent attack and to protect important national interests, and the recent presidential administration held that Article II authorizes "the President to use force against forces of Iran, a state responsible for conducting and directing attacks against United States forces in the [Middle East] region" and for actions the purpose of which are "to end Iran's strategic escalation of attacks on, and threats to United States interests," so the 2002 AUMF is not independently required to authorize any such activities;
