4 (a) IN GENERAL.—No	t later than 180 days after the
5 date of the enactment of the	nis Act, the Secretary of State

14	(b) Approval of Future Peacekeeping Mis-
15	SIONS.—The President shall direct the United States Per-
16	manent Representative to the United Nations to use the
17	voice, vote, and influence of the United States at the
18	United Nations to ensure that no new United Nations
19	peacekeeping mission is approved without a periodic man-
20	date renewal.
21	(e) Funding Limitation.—The United States shall
22	not provide funding for any United Nations peacekeeping
23	mission beginning after the date of the enactment of this
24	Act unless the mission has a periodic mandate renewal.
