2	SEC SENSE OF CONGRESS ON ANTI-ISRAEL AND ANTI-		
3	SEMITIC INCITEMENT WITHIN THE PALES-

5	(a) FINDINGS.—Congress makes the following find-		
6	ings:		
7	(1) The 1995 Interim Agreement on the West		
8	Bank and the Gaza Strip, commonly referred to as		
9	Oslo II, specifically details that Israel and the Pales-		
10	tinian Authority shall "abstain from incitement, in-		
11	cluding hostile propaganda, against each other and,		
12	without derogating from the principle of freedom of

2 1 expression, shall take legal measures to prevent such 2 incitement by any organizations, groups or individ-3 uals within their jurisdiction". 4 (2) In spite of the Oslo II agreement, the Presi-5 dent of the Palestinian Authority, Mahmoud Abbas 6 repeatedly describes released Palestinian terrorists as "heroes" and Fatah's military wing publicly 7 8 threatens to kidnap soldiers and launch missiles at 9 Israel on the Fatah Facebook page and website. 10 (3) The Palestinian Authority pays monthly "salaries" to families of Palestinian terrorists incar-11 12 cerated in Israel. 13 (4) In an address to the United Nations Gen-14 eral Assembly in September 2014, Abbas said, "This 15 last war against Gaza was a series of absolute war crimes" and affirmed that "the Palestinian people 16 17 hold steadfast to their legitimate right to defend 18 themselves against the Israeli war machine and to 19 their legitimate right to resist this colonial, racist Israeli occupation". 20 21 (5) In June 2013, Abbas referenced Israeli acts 22 which "indicate an evil and dangerous plot to de-23 stroy Al-Agsa and build the alleged temple". 24 (6) In a November 2014 address commemo-

rating the 10th anniversary of Yasser Arafat's

1 death, Abbas said that as Israel has no claim to Je-2 rusalem, he will not allow the Temple Mount to be 3 "contaminated by Jews", and threatened that Jewish prayer at the site would cause a "devastating re-4 5 ligious war". 6 (7) In November 2014, jailed terrorist and Fatah leader Marwan Barghouti called for "com-7 8 prehensive resistance and the rifle" against Israel. 9 (8) Palestinian Authority Deputy Minister of Al-Mutawakkil Taha told official 10 Information Palestian Authority daily newspaper Al Hayat Al 11 Jadida in early 2012 that "Israel has gone beyond 12 all forms of oppression practiced by fascism through-13 14 out history" and that it "does more than racist dis-15 crimination and ethnic cleansing". 16 (9) Official Palestinian websites and Facebook 17 pages, including those of Abbas' Presidential Guards 18 and Palestinian Authority schools, recurrently show 19 maps of the land without reference to Israel and in November 2012, the Palestinian Authority erected a 20 21 statue in central Bethlehem square that displayed a map of the "state of Palestine" covering all of 22 23 Israel. (10) The Oslo II agreement further dictates 24

that Israel and the Palestinian Authority "will en-

1 sure that their respective educational systems con-2 tribute to the peace between the Israeli and Palestinian peoples and to peace in the entire region". 3 4 (11) Zayzafuna, a monthly educational maga-5 zine for children sponsored by the Palestinian Na-6 Committee for Education, Culture tional 7 Sciences, regularly presents Adolf Hitler as a role 8 model and in January 2012, Facebook pages of sev-9 eral Palestinian Authority high schools posted images of Hitler with his quotation, "I could have 10 killed all the Jews in the world, but I left a few so 11 12 that you would know why I killed them." (12) A teacher in a summer camp near Nablus 13 14 in July 2013 can be seen in video footage leading 15 children in a call and response saying, "Palestine is 16 an Arab land from the river to the sea. We want 17 Haifa, we want Acre." 18 (13) In July 2013, Palestinian state television 19 aired a video of two girls reciting a poem that calls Jews "barbaric monkeys, wretched pigs" and asserts 20 that Jerusalem is not for Jews, because Jerusalem 21 "vomits" out the Jews who are said to be "filth" 22 and "impure". 23 24 (14) Section 7040(e) of the Consolidated and 25 Further Continuing Appropriations Act, 2015, re-

1	quires the Secretary of State, if the President waives
2	section 7040(a) of that same Act, to "certify and re-
3	port to the Committees on Appropriations prior to
4	the obligation of funds that the Palestinian Au-
5	thority is acting to counter incitement of violence
6	against Israelis and is supporting activities aimed as
7	promoting peace, coexistence, and security coopera-
8	tion with Israel".
9	(15) The Palestinian Authority has not fully
10	lived up to its prior agreements with Israel to end
11	incitement and should do more to prepare the Pales
12	tinian people for peace with Israel.
13	(b) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—Congress—
14	(1) expresses support and admiration for indi-
15	viduals and organizations working to encourage co-
16	operation between Israeli Jews and Palestinians, in-
17	cluding—
18	(A) Professor Mohammed Dajani Daoudi
19	who took students from al-Quds University in
20	Jerusalem to visit Auschwitz in March 2014
21	only to return to death threats by fellow Pal-
22	estinians and expulsion from his teacher's
23	union;

1	(B) the Israel Palestine Center for Re-
2	search and Information, the only joint Israeli-
3	Palestinian public policy think-tank,
4	(C) United Hatzalah, a nonprofit, fully vol-
5	unteer Emergency Medical Services organiza-
6	tion that, mobilizing volunteers who are reli-
7	gious or secular Jews, Arabs, Muslims, and
8	Christians, provides EMS services to all people
9	in Israel regardless of race, religion, or national
10	origin; and
11	(D) Breaking the Impasse, an apolitical
12	initiative of Palestinian and Israeli business and
13	civil society leaders who advocate for a two-
14	state solution and an urgent diplomatic solution
15	to the conflict;
16	(2) reiterates strong condemnation of anti-
17	Israel and anti-Semitic incitement in the Palestinian
18	Authority as antithetical to the cause of peace;
19	(3) urges President Abbas and Palestinian Au-
20	thority officials to discontinue all official incitement
21	and exert influence to discourage anti-Israel and
22	anti-Semitic incitement in Palestinian civil society;
23	and
24	(4) directs the Department of State to regularly
25	monitor and publish information on state-sponsored

- 1 incitement by the Palestinian Authority against
- 2 Jews and the State of Israel.
