- 1 At the end of title III, add the following:
- 2 **SEC. 3 _____ . DEFICIT-NEUTRAL RESERVE FUND RELATING**
- 3 **TO CLIMATE CHANGE NEGOTIATIONS BE-**
- 4 **TWEEN THE UNITED STATES AND CHINA**
- 5 **THAT ENSURE NO TRADING AWAY OF VITAL**
- 6 **UNITED STATES INTERESTS.**

7 The Chairman of the Committee on the Budget of
 8 the Senate may revise the allocations of a committee or
 9 committees, aggregates, and other appropriate levels in
 10 this resolution, and make adjustments to the pay-as-you-

1 go ledger, for one or more bills, joint resolutions, amend-
2 ments, amendments between the Houses, motions, or con-
3 ference reports relating to negotiations between the
4 United States and the People's Republic of China (PRC)
5 on climate change, which may include efforts to ensure
6 that the United States does not enter into any agreement
7 with the PRC with respect to climate change based on the
8 United States trading away its interests or pursuing poli-
9 cies contrary to United States interests in exchange for
10 cooperation or future promises of cooperation by the Peo-
11 ple's Republic of China on climate change by the amounts
12 provided in such legislation for those purposes, provided
13 that such legislation would not increase the deficit over
14 either the period of the total of fiscal years 2021 through
15 2025 or the period of the total of fiscal years 2021
16 through 2030.
