- 1 On page 3, line 22, strike “and” and all that follows
- 2 through line 25, and insert the following:
- 3 (2) in subsection (a)(1), by inserting “or un-
- 4 manned combat aerial vehicles” after “combat air-
- 5 craft”;
- 6 (3) by redesignating subsection (e) as sub-
- 7 section (f); and

1 (4) by inserting after subsection (d), the fol-
2 lowing new subsection (e):

3 “(e) AGREEMENTS RELATED TO NUCLEAR PROGRAM
4 OF IRAN DEEMED TREATIES SUBJECT TO ADVICE AND
5 CONSENT OF THE SENATE.—

6 “(1) TREATY SUBJECT TO ADVICE AND CON-
7 SENT OF THE SENATE.—Notwithstanding any other
8 provision of law, any agreement reached by the
9 President with Iran relating to the nuclear program
10 of Iran is deemed to be a treaty that is subject to
11 the requirements of article II, section 2, clause 2 of
12 the Constitution of the United States requiring that
13 the treaty is subject to the advice and consent of the
14 Senate, with two-thirds of Senators concurring.

15 “(2) LIMITATION ON SANCTIONS RELIEF.—Not-
16 withstanding any other provision of law, the Presi-
17 dent may not waive, suspend, reduce, provide relief
18 from, or otherwise limit the application of sanctions
19 under any other provision of law or refrain from ap-
20 plying any such sanctions pursuant to an agreement
21 related to the nuclear program of Iran that includes
22 the United States, commits the United States to
23 take action, or pursuant to which the United States
24 commits or otherwise agrees to take action, regard-
25 less of the form it takes, whether a political commit-

1 ment or otherwise, and regardless of whether it is le-
2 gally binding or not, including any joint comprehen-
3 sive plan of action entered into or made between
4 Iran and any other parties, and any additional mate-
5 rials related thereto, including annexes, appendices,
6 codicils, side agreements, implementing materials,
7 documents, and guidance, technical or other under-
8 standings, and any related agreements, whether en-
9 tered into or implemented prior to the agreement or
10 to be entered into or implemented in the future, un-
11 less the agreement is subject to the advice and con-
12 sent of the Senate as a treaty and receives the con-
13 currence of two-thirds of Senators.”.
