- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- This Act may be cited as the "Stand with Israel Act".

10	"No funds made available to the Department of State
11	or any other Federal department or agency may be made

14	lated entities that expels, downgrades or suspends mem-
15	bership, or otherwise restricts the participation of Israel
16	such that it may not participate fully and equivalently with
17	other Member States of the United Nations or the respec-
18	tive fund, program, specialized agency, or other related en-
19	tity.".
